RESPECT Policy

The Local Authority have updated the Respect Policy for schools and council settings, and have produced posters to summarise the main points. I have attached them to this newsletter and they are on display in the front entrance of school.

The key message the LA want to share is as follows:

We will not tolerate inappropriate behaviour of any kind. This includes bullying or inappropriate behaviour that is based upon or refers to one or more of the 9 protected characteristics (Equality Act 2010). These include race: religion, gender, disability and LGBTQ+.

Year 4 Beliefs and Values
