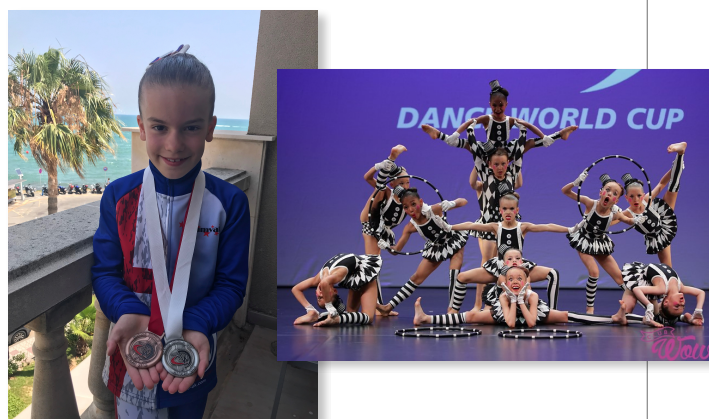
## Festival Shield Success!

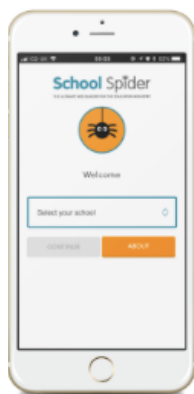


## Another Sporting Achievement.....
