#### General Election

As you will have no doubt heard in the news, a General Election has been called and polling will take place on Thursday 4th July. Stockport Council designate a large number of schools to serve as polling stations. Normally, when council elections are held, we can manage the smaller numbers in the staff room and keep the school open. However, for General Elections we have to use the school hall and the main entrance. Therefore, for safeguarding reasons, we will have to close the school to children.



In order to help parents with a childcare solution, we are proposing to open our Busy Bees club for the day, from 7.30am to 5.45pm. There would be a flat rate of £40 for the day. Encourage your child to consider how an ill-judged message might damage their reputation or upset a friend who sent something to them in confidence.
