## Extra Curricular Clubs

Now we have established routines and adapted to further Covid guidance, we are now in a position to offer extra curricular clubs to our pupils. We are re-introducing lunchtime clubs to encourage more children to take part. As these are within the school day, there is no charge. However, after school clubs will continue to be charged at £4.50 a session to cover staffing and coaching costs.

A separate letter will be sent home today with further details, dates and booking information so please refer to this if you would like to book a place. Please note that parents do not need to book lunchtime clubs - these will be organised by the teachers. Have a look at what's on offer and please encourage your child to attend if they can. The tennis club needs to be booked directly through Point One Tennis - the link can be found on the Club letter coming home.

Places will be awarded on a first come, first served basis. If a club is over subscribed it may be repeated in the Spring Term and a waiting list created.

With the exception of Athletics, clubs will start the week beginning 11th October and will run for 8 weeks, finishing week beginning 6th December.
