Welcome back Year 5! We hope that you had a lovely and restful holiday and are refreshed and ready to continue working hard

this year.



This term we will begin our topic "Half the World Away" which is a Science and Geography-based topic. Throughout the term, the children will be learning about Earth and Space, including looking at the movement of the Earth and other planets

relative to the Sun, investigating why we have night and day, and understanding time zones. We will also be focusing on North America, researching famous landmarks and locating them on the map as well as distinguishing between human and physical features.

Enalish

During this term, we will start the term off by looking at different pieces of data and trying to analyse and interpret these. These will include line graphs, tables and tally charts. Then we will start our work on multiplication and division, including short multiplication, long multiplication and using the bus stop method to divide 3 and 4 digit numbers by a 1 digit number.
