Congratulations!

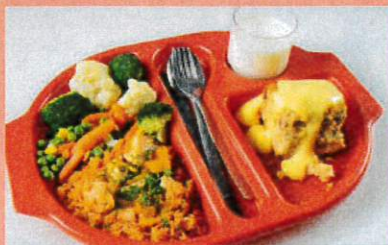
What a busy time it has been in school this week! Well done to:
